The Work: 4 days/week through the summer at an inner-city organization for paid practical work experience.

The Study: 1 day week, 6 credit course at the 3000 level. Focusing on community practice and theory with a reconciliation lens. This unique course will expose you to a variety of issues affecting the inner city as well as community based practices in economic, social, and community development. You will explore the everyday realities and context of community based programs and services. In the spirit of Reconciliation the curriculum explores the root causes of divisions in contemporary Canadian society, which are often based on fear, ignorance and lack of exposure to people from different backgrounds

and experiences.

Elder Support: Is available to provide mentorship and guidance to students and to the program.

Location: This course uses a roving classroom model where students visit different locations in the inner city.

With challenging topics and a roving classroom - prepare to be uncomfortable.
