contemporary Canadian society, which are often based on fear, ignorance and lack of exposure to people from different backgrounds and experiences.

Elder Support: Is available to provide mentorship and guidance to students and to the program.

Location: Depending on pandemic restrictions this course may use a roving classroom model where students visit different locations in the inner city.
